

PORT OF HOOD RIVER

RESOLUTION No. 1976-77 -- 1

WHEREAS there has been extensive negotiations between certain property owners within the clear zone of the West end of the Hood River Airport both by Hood River County and the Port of Hood River, and

WHEREAS the Federal Aviation Administration has encouraged and insisted that the airport be brought into compliance by the acquisition of certain aviation easements or the acquisition of fee title to lands within the clear zone and adjacent areas, and

WHEREAS it is the intentions of the Port of Hood River to expedite the acquisition of the property interests necessary or desirable to place the airport in compliance,

NOW THEREFORE, the Port of Hood River resolves to immediately commence to acquire the necessary property interests to bring the airport into compliance as required by the Federal Aviation Administration by the acquisition of aviation easements or fee title to the real property in and under the westerly clear zone, transitional approach area and adjacent areas by negotiations and, if necessary, condemnation.

The Port Manager, Assistant Manager and attorney are directed to take the necessary steps to acquire the necessary properties.
