AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE


Thursday, January 25, 2018

At WAAAM – 3:00pm

- 1. Approval of Minutes for December 21, 2017. Moved by J. Benton, 2nd by Bill Avolio
- 2. Introductions- no intro's made
- 3. Airport Project updates

Anne updated the Committee regarding the phasing changes for the COVI project and proposed changes. She will bring a visual schematic to the next meeting so the committee can see where items will be located. There was some discussion about stormwater and wetland mitigation and if the Port's project could help with WAAAM's stormwater pond issue. Anne said the engineers are looking into a potential solution for that.

- 4. FBO update- Its been slow by instruction calls have increased. 1,100 gallons of fuel were sold last month, which is up from last year. Anne requested that the FBO report that is furnished to the Port be ready by the time AAC meetings are held. Tricycle gear training has mostly moved to the Dalles airport with tail wheal remaining in hood river. There was discussion about this. The price is the same regardless of the type of plane you fly (barring the super Cubs).
- 5. WAAAM Update three summer cruise lines have been scheduled for the upcoming season. This brings a lot of traffic to WAAAM and has been increasing annually.
- 6. Glider Update- none.
- 7. Fly Friendly program discussion- Paige works will be working on the flyer in February so it can be completed by the March 1 public deadline.
- 8. Other items to discuss
 - a. Todd Guenther has had multiple planes flying low over the river by his house. He has not been able to identify them and it continues to be an issue.



 b. Dale Harris had an issue with an unleashed dog who aggressively approached him and had to be called off by the owner. Per Ordinance 23, all animals must be on a lease and in control of their owners at all times. Should this happen again, Mr. Harris is encouraged to get the individuals name and call the Port.
