A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BOARD MEMBER TRAINING ON PUBLIC MEETINGS LAW

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has enacted HB 2805, which mandates that each board member of a governing body with total expenditures of \$1 million or more during a fiscal year must complete training on public meetings law; and

WHEREAS, this training must be provided or approved by the Oregon Government Ethics Commission; and

WHEREAS, ensuring that all Board members are well-informed about public meetings law is essential for compliance and effective governance; NOW THEREFORE

THE PORT OF HOOD RIVER BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Training Requirement: Each Board member shall attend or complete a training session on public meetings law at least once during their term, effective January 1, 2024.

Section 2. Approval of Training: The training must be provided or approved by the Oregon Government Ethics Commission.

Section 3. Documentation: Board members are required to submit evidence of completed training to the Port's administration for record-keeping.

Section 4. Implementation: Staff is directed to codify this policy into the Governance Policy according to past administrative practices and ensuring all Board members are aware of their training obligations.
