WHEREAS, the Hood River Urban Renewal Agency is the duly constituted Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Hood River; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Renewal Agency Members include one representative each from the Hood River City Council and the Hood River City Planning Commission, two Commissioners from the Port of Hood River, and three citizens-at-large from Hood River;

WHEREAS, the Hood River Urban Renewal Agency has prepared an Urban Renewal Plan (know as the Columbia-Cascade Development Plan) and an accompanying Report on such Plan;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Columbia-Cascade Development Plan is to eliminate blight and depreciating property values, attract job producing private investments that will improve property values and establish a positive linkage between the Development Area and the Columbia River;

WHEREAS, on June 21, 1988, the Planning Commission of the City of Hood River conducted a public hearing on the Columbia-Cascade Development Plan and found that it is in compliance with the City Comprehensive Plan and recommended its approval by Resolution 88-1 to the City Council.

WHEREAS, on July 6, 1988, the Council of the City of Hood River, after conducting a public hearing, adopted Ordinance #1601 approving the Urban Renewal Plan.

WHEREAS, the Columbia-Cascade Development Plan has been prepared consistent with the economic development policies of the Mid-Columbia Economic Development District (MCEDD); and

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River supports the goals and objectives of the Columbia-Cascade Development Plan;
