

**Resolution 2000-01-4**

**(A resolution setting the fee for filing a claim for compensation under Ballot Measure 7)**

WHEREAS, the Port of Hood River ("Port") has adopted Ordinance 21 establishing a procedure for submitting an application for compensation arising under the provisions of Section 18, Article I of the Oregon Constitution, as amended by Ballot Measure 7 adopted November 7, 2000;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 21 provides that a notice of claim must be accompanied by a filing fee to be established by resolution of the Port Commission;

WHEREAS, the following fee is necessary and proper;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port of Hood River Commission that:

The fee for filing a notice of claim under Ordinance 21 shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or two percent (2%) of the amount claimed, whichever is greater, payable at the time of submittal of the application to the Port.


